We appreciate it that you consider attending our Engineering School. You have made an excellent choice, and we are sure that the Engineering School will be a fun-filled learning experience.

Attached please find the application and indemnity forms. Both forms must reach us as soon as possible with your deposit slip or a cheque as proof of payment. A limited number of places are available, and the applications will be filled on a first come first served basis. A unique registration number will be allocated and bank details will be sent to you after receiving the application form.

### A few practical arrangements to ensure a pleasant stay:

**Arrival and Registration (10h00-12h00):** Foyer of ***Dennepark Guest House***. You will receive a map to Dennepark upon registration. After registration you can commence to Campus, building G20 where refreshments will be served. The welcoming speech starts at 12h00. There will be directions on campus from the gates in Meyer Street (main entrance) as well as the gate in Steve Biko Avenue (Tom Street).

### Cost:

- \* R 850 (meals included, accommodation excluded)

**Accommodation:** You will stay at Dennepark Guesthouse. These PUK facilities have double rooms and are used for accommodation for short courses on campus.

**Additional accommodation:** Unfortunately we cannot make provision for learners that stay an extra night. You are however most welcome to contact **Paljas Backpackers** at **018 297 0681**. They are within walking distance from Dennepark and the campus.

**Admission Test:** All entrants into the engineering program must conduct an admission test. This is not an aptitude or career planning test, but rather an engineering specific measuring instrument to point out learner's specific areas of strength and improvement. We highly advise that Grade 12 learners that plans to enrol for engineering studies conduct this test on **Monday 14 June** from 12h00-17h00. Please confirm this on the application form. **Clothing:** Bring along comfortable clothing, as the Engineering School is very informal. Just remember to bring along some warm clothing.
